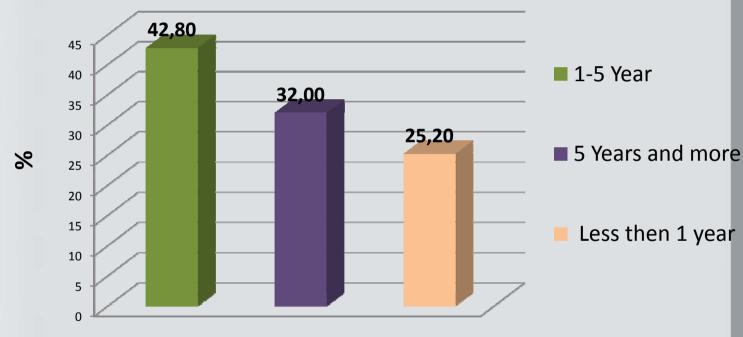








Studied enterprises operating duration



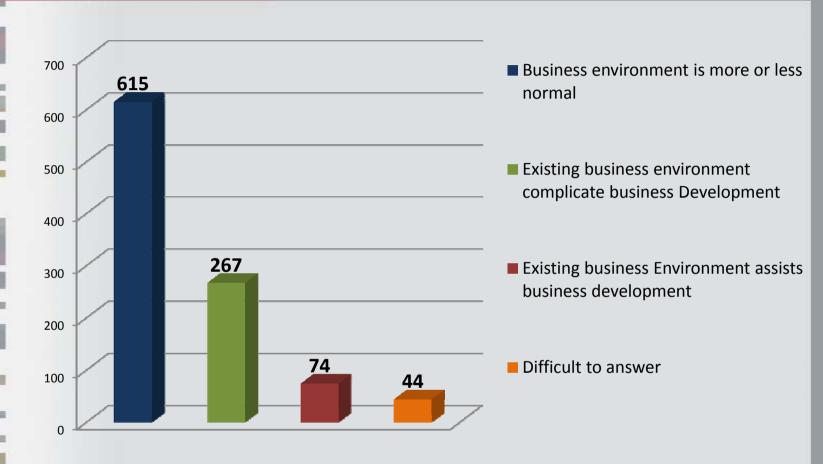
According to official data's 51 279 enterprise are registered, 23.2% increase compared to previous year

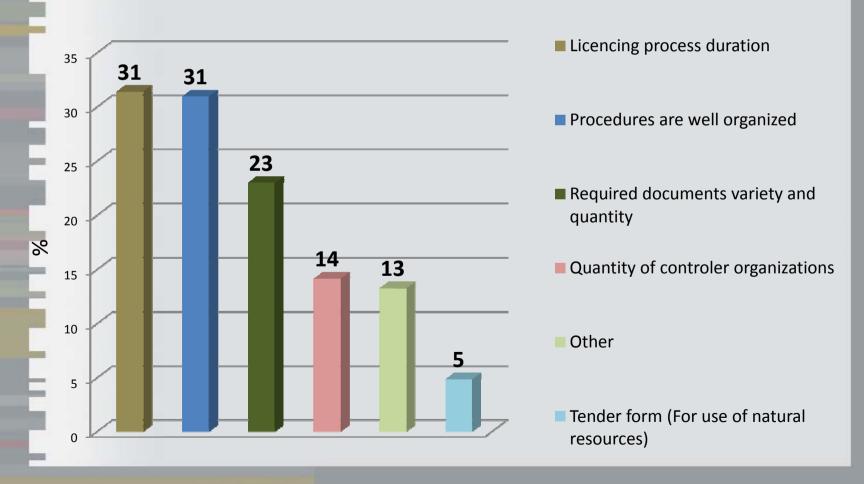

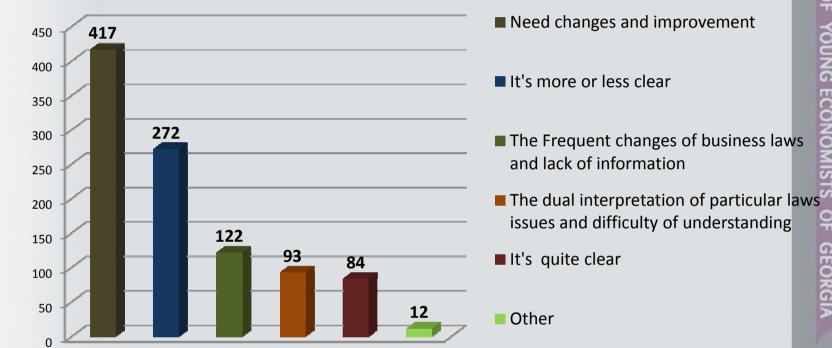

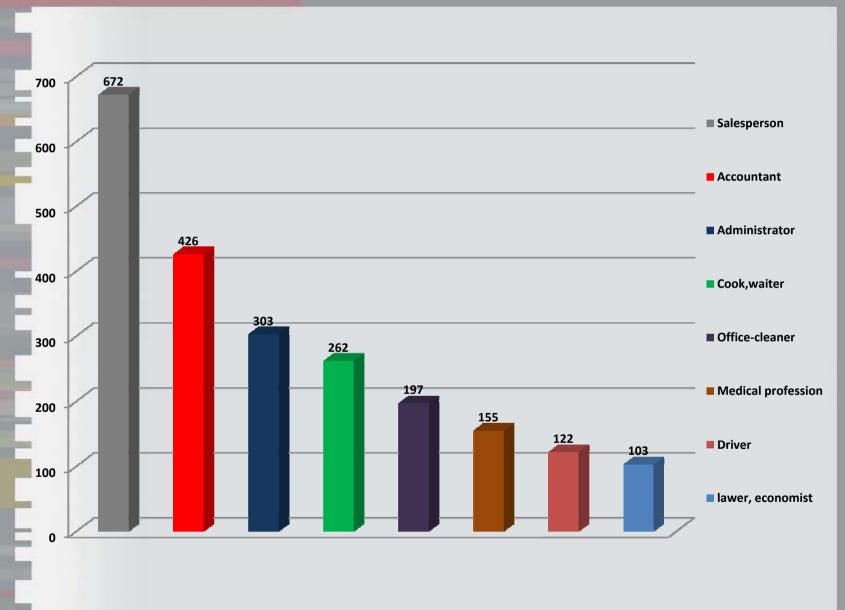

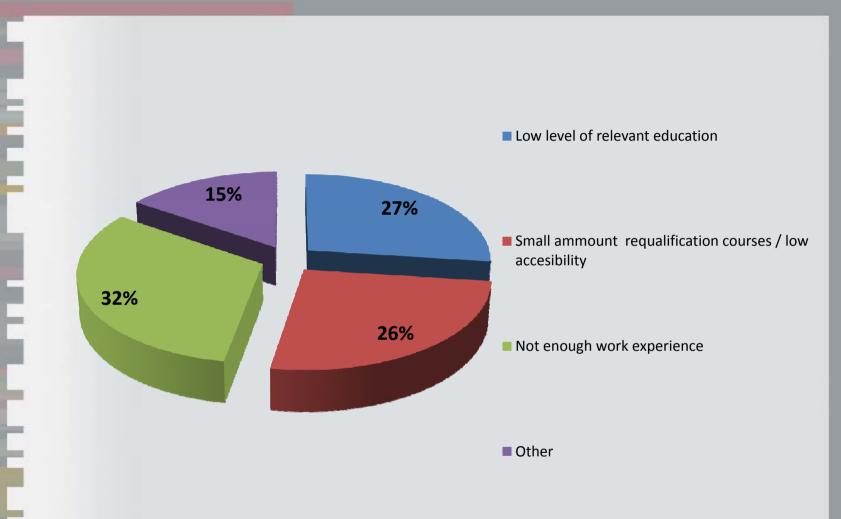
employees by positions in surveyed organizations



Demand on position in upcoming year



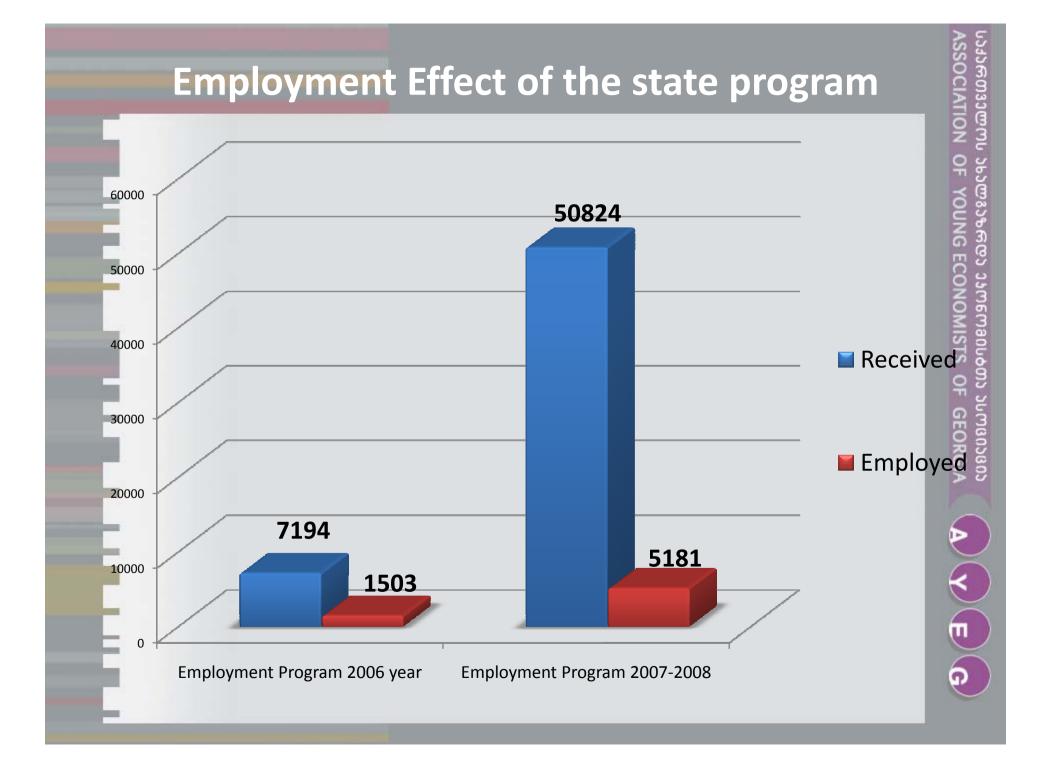

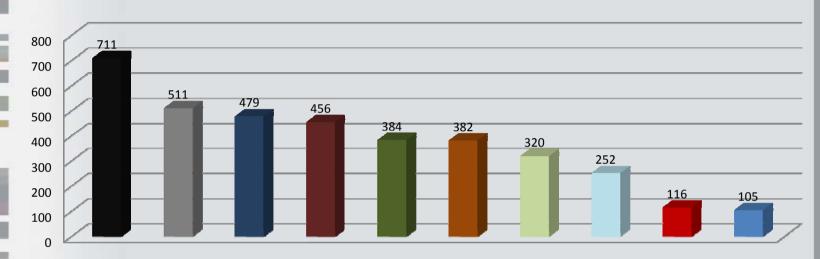


- Respondents who have participated in the state program had received 50 824 persons;

Top 10 problems of bussiness sector

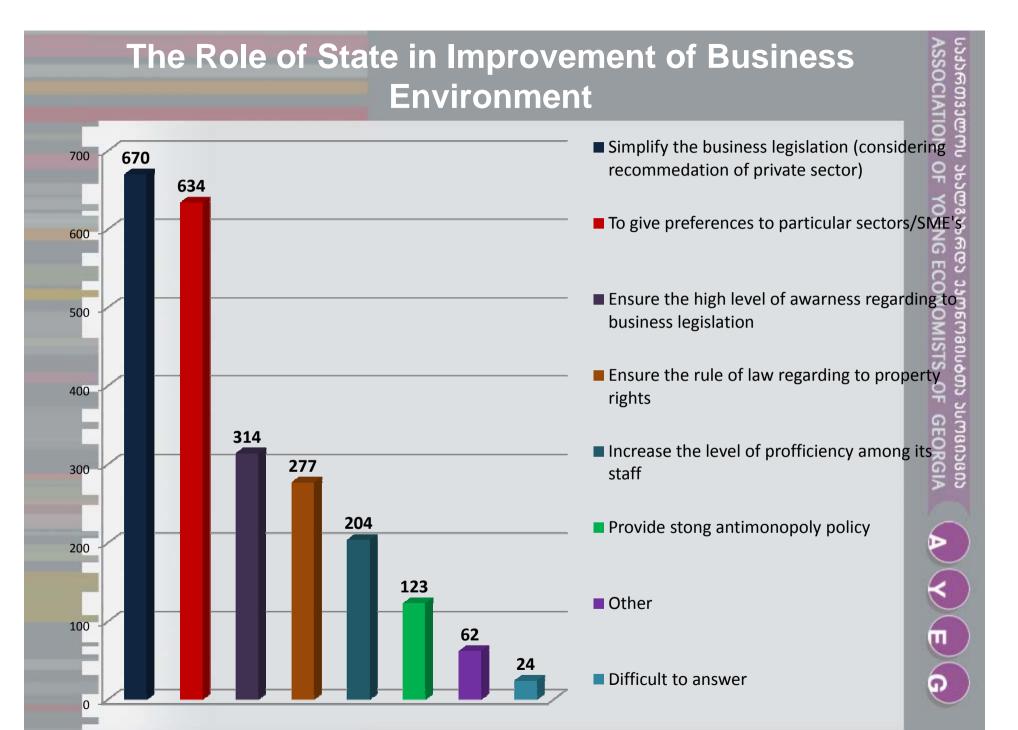


- Difficulty of undestanding the business legislation
